<b>and</b> Joins ideas that are <b>similar</b> . <i>I like pizza <b>and</b> pasta.</i>	<b>because</b> Shows <b>reason</b> . <i>I tripped <b>because</b> I ran.</i>
<b>but</b> Joins ideas that are <b>opposite</b> . <i>I like vanilla <b>but</b> I don't like chocolate.</i>	<b>so</b> Shows <b>result</b> . <i>It was hot <b>so</b> I went swimming.</i>
<b>or</b> Shows <b>choice</b> . <i>Should we fish <b>or</b> swim?</i>	<b>if</b> Shows <b>condition</b> . <i>If I put on sunscreen I won't get burnt.</i>
