

## Subject and Predicate

The predicate tells us what the subject of the sentence **does** or **is**.

Sam's new bike *was the fastest in the school*.

The subject is the person, place, animal, thing or idea that is **doing the action** or **being something**.

\*To find it, think to yourself *who or what is doing the action?*
